

# **2022/23 PRICES**

For weddings in The 1829 Room the following minimum spends will apply:

#### JANUARY TO OCTOBER

Saturday (& Sunday bank holiday): £3,000 + 12.5% service charge

Sunday to Friday: £2,250 + 12.5% service charge

#### **NOVEMBER TO JANUARY**

Saturday (& Sunday bank holiday): £2,500 + 12.5% service charge

Sunday to Friday: £2,000 + 12.5% service charge

For weddings that require exclusive hire of the pub the following minimum spends will apply:

#### ALL YEAR

Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holiday: £12,000 + 12.5% service charge

Friday: £10,000 + 12.5% service charge

Monday to Thursday: £8,000 + 12.5% service charge

Minimum spends cover both food and drink. There is no additional hire fee.



# YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

#### ROOM VIEWINGS

We are happy to let you have a look at The 1829 room any time when we are open and the room is free. We highly recommend calling in advance to see if the rooms are available and there is a member of staff to show you around. Turning up on the day can cause disappointment which we would like to avoid.

#### **MEETINGS**

The manager holds meetings Monday-Wednesday evenings by appointment.

These must be scheduled at least 10 days prior.

PLEASE NOTE: We do not hold meetings or tastings in December and on Bank Holidays.

#### MENU TASTINGS

Wedding tastings are held on Monday-Wednesday evenings. They must be booked 14 days in advance and menu choices must be with us at least seven days in advance. During this you will also be able to try wines we offer by the glass. Food and wine (125ml glasses) are free of charge. Wines by the bottle will be charged with a 25% discount. **PLEASE NOTE:** We do not hold meetings or tastings in December and on Bank Holidays.

#### VENUE

The 1829 room is situated on the first floor. Access is via stairs located just next to the bar. The entire pub can be booked for exclusive hire as per above information. The Courtyard is included with bookings in The 1829 Room for one hour (arrival or reception drinks) any additional time after this will be charged at £100 an hour.

#### **OPENING HOURS**

Friday & Saturday: Main bar downstairs open until 12am / Upstairs until bar open 12am Guests are asked to vacate The 1829 room at 12am and the premises by 12.30am

**Sunday**: Main bar open until 10.30pm / Upstairs bar open until 10.30pm Guests are asked to vacate the premises by 11pm

**Sunday (Bank Holidays)**: Main bar open until 12am / Upstairs bar open until 12am Guests are asked to vacate the 1829 room at 12am and the premises by 12.30am

Monday to Thursday: Main bar open until 11pm / Upstairs bar open until 11pm Guests are asked to vacate the premises by 11.30pm

#### **CEREMONIES**

# YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

#### **CAPACITIES**

The 1829 Room: 50 seated on five or six individual rectangle tables or two banquet tables. Circular tables can be provided on request with a hire fee.

#### DISABLED ACCESS

Unfortunately, the only access to the first floor is via stairs.

The ground floor has level access and there is an accessible toilet.

#### HOTEL ROOMS

We have five new hotel rooms on the second floor. We suggest you check room availability when choosing your wedding date and book any rooms required at the time of paying your deposit. These rooms are ideal for the bride to stay and get ready in the morning or for couples to start married life together.

#### **CHILDREN**

Children are more than welcome to attend weddings at The Princess Victoria, and we have a dedicated children's menu. Children must be supervised at all times and must not be in the downstairs areas after 9pm. The latter does not apply to exclusive hire.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

The 1829 Room is air-conditioned.

There are toilets on the first floor with additional toilets located on the ground floor.

Baby changing facilities are available on the ground floor.

#### BAR

We have a bar in The 1829 Room. It has Kronenbourg draught beer and a condensed version of drinks that are available downstairs.

#### CORKAGE

If you would like to bring your own wine, we are able to offer corkage at £18.50 a bottle for still wine and £25 for sparkling wine.

#### CATERING

We have an in-house catering team and unfortunately do not allow the use of outside caterers with the exclusion of wedding cakes.

#### **ROOM SETUP**

We provide white linen tablecloths and napkins, glassware, cutlery and crockery. We have tealights and holders that can be used. We do not supply decorations, but you are more than welcome to decorate the room.

#### CHANGING FACILITIES

We have five hotel rooms on the second floor that can be booked the night before or after. We suggest you check room availability when choosing your wedding date and book any rooms required at the time of paying your deposit.

# YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

# **ENTERTAINMENT**

Live music must finish at 11pm after which only recorded music is allowed until midnight.

The windows must remain closed but we have a more than adequate air conditioning system.

Bands, DJs, etc. must have vacated the premises by the same time as guests.

Due to the close proximity of our neighbours, strict noise limits must be adhered to.

The manager's say is final.

#### AUDIO VISUAL FACILITIES

The 1829 room has a permanent sound system with input for each located in the rooms. The sound systems are linked so the same music can be played in both rooms from one input.

Inputs are via a 3.5mm jack lead (mini-jack or headphone) which we provide.

There is a permanent projector in The 1829 Room with a 2m screen. Connection to the projector is via a VGA or hami input. We have a MAC adaptor (mini DVI - VGA) if needed.

We have a wireless microphone that can be used for speeches if required.

## **CONFETTI**

We do not allow confetti inside or outside the venue. A cleaning charge will apply if this is not adhered to.

#### **GARDENS**

Use of the courtyard for one hour is included for arrival drinks, two hours for ceremonies held with us. The front terrace can only be booked as part of an exclusive hire of the pub. All gardens close at 11pm as per our premises license.

#### ACCESS TO THE ROOMS

Access for suppliers and deliveries on the day is from 10am. As we have events most nights, we are unable to offer access for set up prior to the day. Any suppliers (for example florists) who require the tables to be laid will need to speak to us in advance, so a suitable time can be agreed for delivery and storage.

# **PARKING**

There is no car park at The Princes Victoria but all the surrounding roads are free in the evenings and at the weekends. Monday to Friday day times it is pay and display.

**Trains:** Shepherd's Bush overground (approx 20 minute walk)
Acton Central (approx. 20 minute walk)

**Tube:** Shepherd's Bush Market, Hammersmith and City line (approx. 15 minute walk)
Shepherd's Bush, Central Line, (approx. 20 minute walk)

# WHAT TO DO NEXT

If you have decided The Princess Victoria is your wedding venue, please contact us to discuss dates. We will then ask you to sign terms and conditions and pay your deposit.

Please note weddings are not confirmed until the deposit has been received and t&c's agreed.

The 1829 room requires a £500 deposit and for exclusive hire £1000.

This can be paid by card over the phone or in person.

Closer to your wedding day we will be in touch to organise your food and drink options.
